

Volunteers for Barnabas Schools Team

Churches Together in All Lincolnshire, The Diocese of Lincoln Board of Education and BRF/ Barnabas in Schools is partnering together to develop a team that works in Primary Schools delivering creative R.E. Days.

We are looking for people who might be interested in joining its volunteer team to deliver these programmes. Resources, ideas and training will be provided but each person will deliver this according to their own skill set. We are looking for people who have some experience of working with primary school children and who are able to share our Christian story appropriately within the educational context. The approach used involves using a mixture of games, drama, storytelling styles, music and other creative arts according to the strengths of those involved.

Our vision is for every child that attends a primary school in Lincolnshire, North Lincolnshire and North East Lincolnshire to experience an R.E. day and gain a better understanding of the bible. In order to do this we hope to have 100 volunteers who work in regions, working in twos, delivering the RE days at least once a term. Your travel costs at 25p per mile, would be covered and because of the nature of the work, it is essential that all of the team are drivers.

If you felt this might be something you would like to pursue further then please do send us your CV including details of any teaching qualifications you have, any experience you have in primary schools and any particular creative arts skill (music, drama, mime, dance, etc.) that you can offer.

If you could include the names and addresses of two people who can provide references, preferably relating to your work in schools that would be helpful. Successful applicants will also be required to undertake an enhanced CRB clearance.

We are hoping to begin this project in the near future.
